Aristotelia Serrata (Wineberry/Makomako) <b>SOLD OUT</b>	Fast growing, wind tolerant tree that can grow up to 10m. An ideal pioneer species that birds love. Great for both riparian planting and revegetation. Tolerates full sun, wet feet and light frost.	PB3 (1.8litre) Approx' 50cm high	\$4 + gst each
Carex Secta	Hardy, fast growing sedge that prefers wet feet. Ideal for riparian/wetland planting, and its large root system is perfect for erosion control on stream banks Grows up to 1.5m high.	PB3 (1.8litre) Approx' 50cm high	\$4 + gst each

Coprosma Robusta (Karamu)	Fast growing shrub that is an important pioneer species. Tolerates full sun or full shade, poor soil and attracts birdlife. Ideal for both riparian planting and revegetation. Grows to about 5m.	PB3 (1.8litre) Approx' 50cm high	\$4 + gst each
Cordyline Australis (Cabbage Tree)	An important colonising species that is attractive to birds and ideal for riparian planting, revegetation and erosion control. Grows up to 10m and tolerates wet and dry conditions.	PB3 (1.8litre) Approx' 50cm high	\$4 + gst each
Chamaecytisus palmensis (Tree Lucerne/Tagasaste) <b>SOLD OUT</b>	An attractive exotic species that is perfect for revegetation and erosion control. Deep rooted, nitrogen-fixing and a great nursing species for natives. Tolerates dry and moist conditions and grows to about 10m	PB3 (1.8litre) Approx' 50cm high	\$4 + gst each
Hebe Stricta/Veronica Stricta (Koromiko)	Fast growing shrub that tolerates poor soil and dry conditions. Best in full sun and tolerates wind. Ideal for revegetation and erosion control. Grows to about 4m.	PB3 (1.8litre) Approx' 50cm high	\$4 + gst each
